PASTOR EMERITUS REPORT

I asked Google how often a person who worships in a Protestant congregation invites someone they know to join them in worship. The response was 60% of Protestant churchgoers invite someone at least once to join them in a six-month period. The statistics went further. Lutherans are the least likely group with some studies suggesting an average of one invitation every seven years! Wow. Many people reported they have never invited another person to join them.

One of the first instructions of the Risen Jesus to the women who met Him at the empty tomb was to “go, tell the disciples and Peter...”

I offer a challenge to every Trinity person. “**Each One Invite One.**” It might be a neighbor with whom you have talked and who shared they were struggling with some aspect of their lives. It might be a person you know who is grieving and needing a supportive community. It could be someone who is dealing with shame or a feeling like they can never be forgiven for something in their past. It may be a person you know at school or at work and you sense their life would be positively impacted with the Good News that God loves them specifically, that Jesus died and rose for them, that God wants to be real in their life.

“Each One Invite One.”

St. Paul wrote to the Roman Christians, “How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have never heard? And how can they hear without someone ‘proclaiming’ to them?” In other words, “how will they know they are loved by God if no one tells them?”

“EACH ONE INVITE ONE.”

I am thinking every seven years may not be what Jesus had in mind.

So, to go along with my challenge, here is suggestion:

1. Make a list of people you know who you think might appreciate an invitation.
2. Make a point of listening to them (or even one of them) in the next month to hear what’s happening in their life.
3. Engage them in conversation about what things are important to them, what things hurt in their life, etc.
4. Pray about that person. Lift them up to God. Ask God to open a door (or a window) to an opportunity for you to make an invitation.
5. When that opportunity presents itself, ask them to join you in worship at Trinity because you have been uplifted, comforted, forgiven, encouraged. (Make the invitation consistent with something you have heard in your conversations.)
6. If they say no. It’s ok. Continue to lift them in prayer! Don’t take the no personally. Continue to relate to them graciously.
7. If they say yes. Commit to meeting them here and introducing them to others in the Trinity family! Continue to relate to them graciously.
